

## Little Rice Flowage

**Directions:** From Crandon, travel west 2.07 miles on Hwy. 8/32. to County S, turn north 1.15 miles turn left (west) on Old 8 Road, 2.28 miles to Flowage Ln, turn right (north) 1.1 miles to the boat landing. Large wild-life area, wild rice beds. 1201 quiet water acres to explore.

## Himley Lake

**Directions:** From Crandon, travel east 1.6 miles on Hwy. 8/32. to County W turn south 12.57 miles to Richardson Lake Road, turn left 1/8 mile to FS Road on left, turn left 3/4 mile to boat landing. 145 quiet water acres to explore. USFS parking fee may be required.

## Wabikon & Riley Lakes

**Directions:** From Crandon, travel east 5.5 miles on Hwy. 8/32. to Potawatomi Trail turn south 0.2 miles to the boat landing. This is a quiet two lake chain with remote camping on each lake.

733 quiet water acres to explore.

## Ludington Lake

**Directions:** From Crandon, travel east 1.6 miles on Hwy. 8/32. to County W turn south 9.77 miles to Robert's Lake Road, turn north 1.38 miles to Forest Service road to right, turn right 0.1 miles to boat landing. 29 quiet water acres to explore. USFS parking fee may be required.

## Scattered Rice Lake and Rat River

**Directions:** From Crandon, travel east 10.26 miles on Hwy. 8/32. to Connor Farm Rd. turn north 0.19 miles to bend in road before bridge, boat landing is 200 feet north of bridge on dirt road. Large wildlife area. Quiet river to the West, Lake impoundment to East. Wild rice beds. 428 quiet water acres to explore.

## Bogbrook Impoundment

**Directions:** From Crandon, travel east 1.6 miles on Hwy. 8/32. to County W turn right (south) 6.72 miles to County Q, turn right (southwest) on Q 6.72 miles to County DD miles, turn left (east) on DD 2.94 miles to dirt road to the left (east), turn left 3/4 mile to boat landing. 490 quiet water acres to explore.

Special Features include an ADA accessible pier, fishing platform and kayak launch.
